Southgate launches redeveloped centre and new art experiences this weekend

- The refurbished Southgate unveiled following \$26 million upgrade

Southgate, the iconic Melbourne dining and shopping destination, has been relaunched with a host of new and exciting retailers and restaurants, a revamped design, improved ambience and enhanced customer experience.

To mark the occasion, the Southgate Fiesta launch will take place from Friday 11 November to Sunday 13 November with a variety of entertainment including sunset salsa dance classes and live music on the Southbank Promenade.

Southgate will host aerial performances and street theatre staged by Melbourne artists along with restaurant and retailer tours, new cutting-edge entertainment and much more. The celebrations will be topped off by evening rooftop fireworks.

The completion of Southgate's redevelopment includes an expanded retailer mix designed to meet the need of locals with a focus on arts-related shopping, homewares and youth fashion. The property has also been refurbished to increase the visibility of the unique and spectacular city views across the Yarra River.

DEXUS Property Group Head of Retail, Glyn Williams said the \$26 million upgrade reaffirms Southgate's position as the dining and retail destination of choice.

"Visitors now have so much to rediscover at Southgate with its new dining, retail, arts and entertainment focus. Visitors to Southgate can now enjoy a range of new entertainment attractions including the Southgate Cinema - a free indoor cinema set up on the upper level where visitors are able to enjoy a screening of a classic, art-house, documentary or short film in a relaxed setting.

Southgate's resident art attraction, *Ophelia*, has been restored and relocated to a new home on the promenade and a new major sculpture, *Riverside Corolla* by John Meade, now adorns the atrium space at the main entrance and is spectacularly illuminated at night.

A number of innovative new art installations have also been curated as part of the makeover and are reflective of Melbourne's arts culture. These state-of-the-art installations are a first for a major retail destination in Australia.

In particular, the new Interactive Pillars are a digital installation located on the upper level. The five LED pillars are activated by the movement of passers-by and through a network of sensors, allowing the lights and the art to react to the movement of the customer.



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A new digital Floor Projection experience will take place on the mid-level reflecting Melbourne's ever changing four seasons. Visitors will be able to walk through petals in spring, crisp leaves in autumn and admire the city's lights in winter.
